## Notification of changes in upcoming UX Pro Edge firmware update.

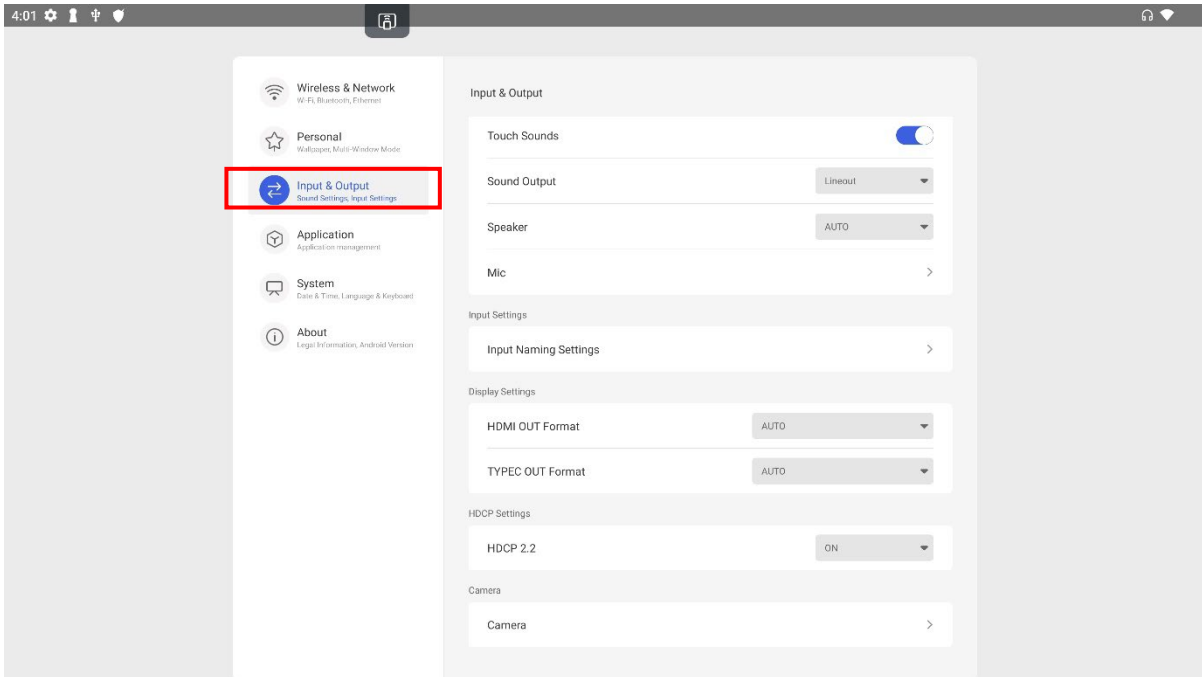
We are pleased to announce the release of the next UX Pro Edge update. This release brings the following features, functionality, improvements and changes:

- 18. Multi-window resizing interface colour has been updated**

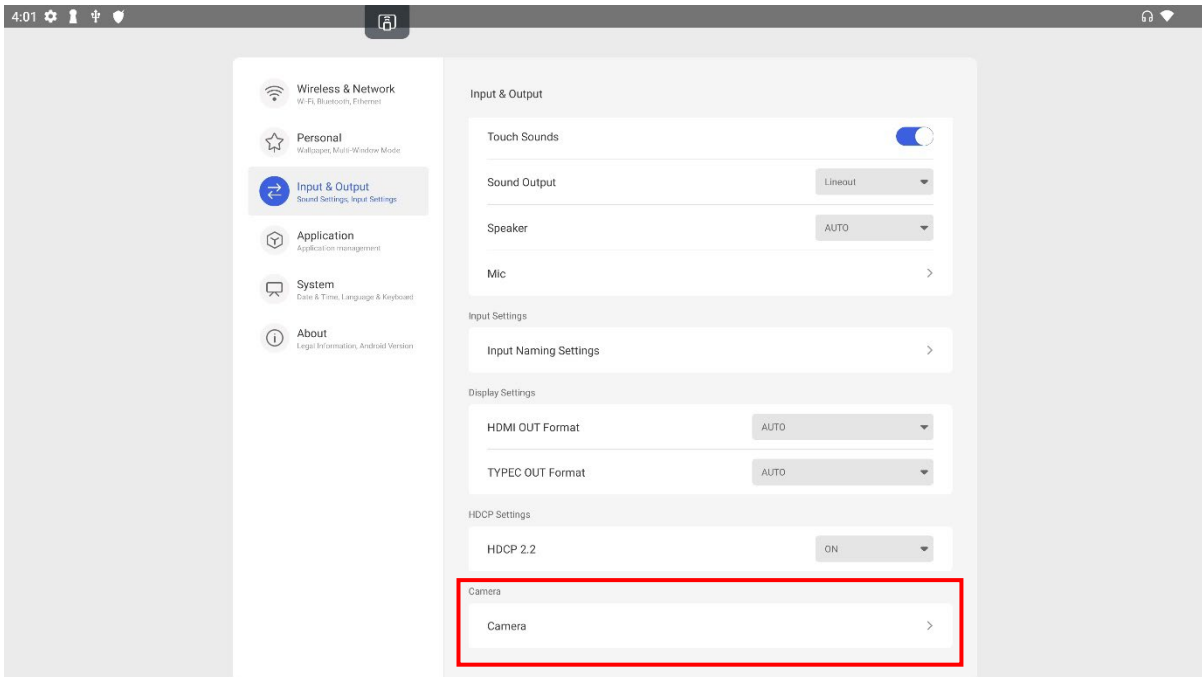

### How do I enable speaker tracking?

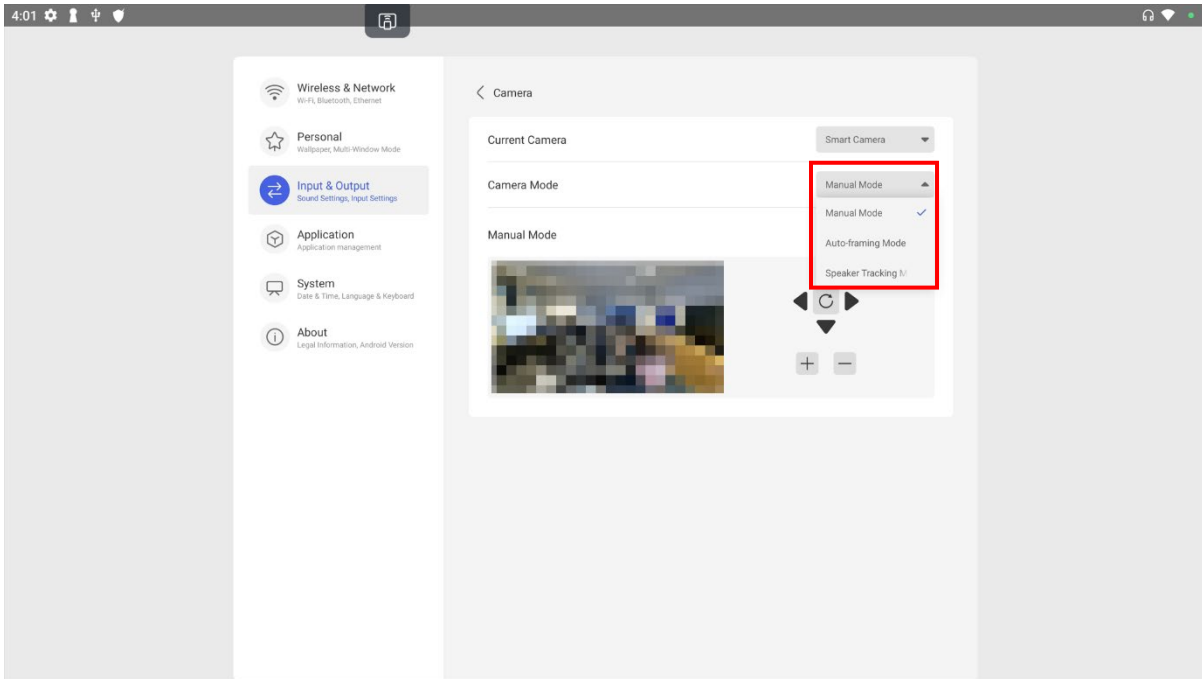
1. Open Settings > Input & Output



2. Select Camera

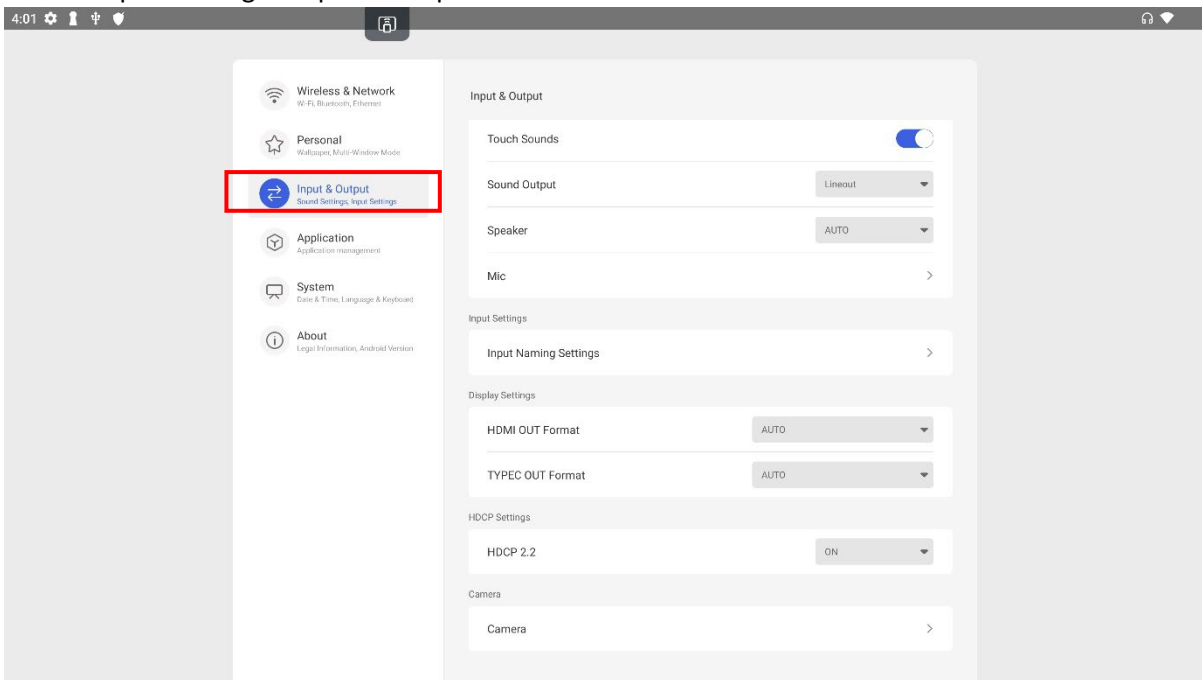


3. Select Camera Mode > Speaker Tracking

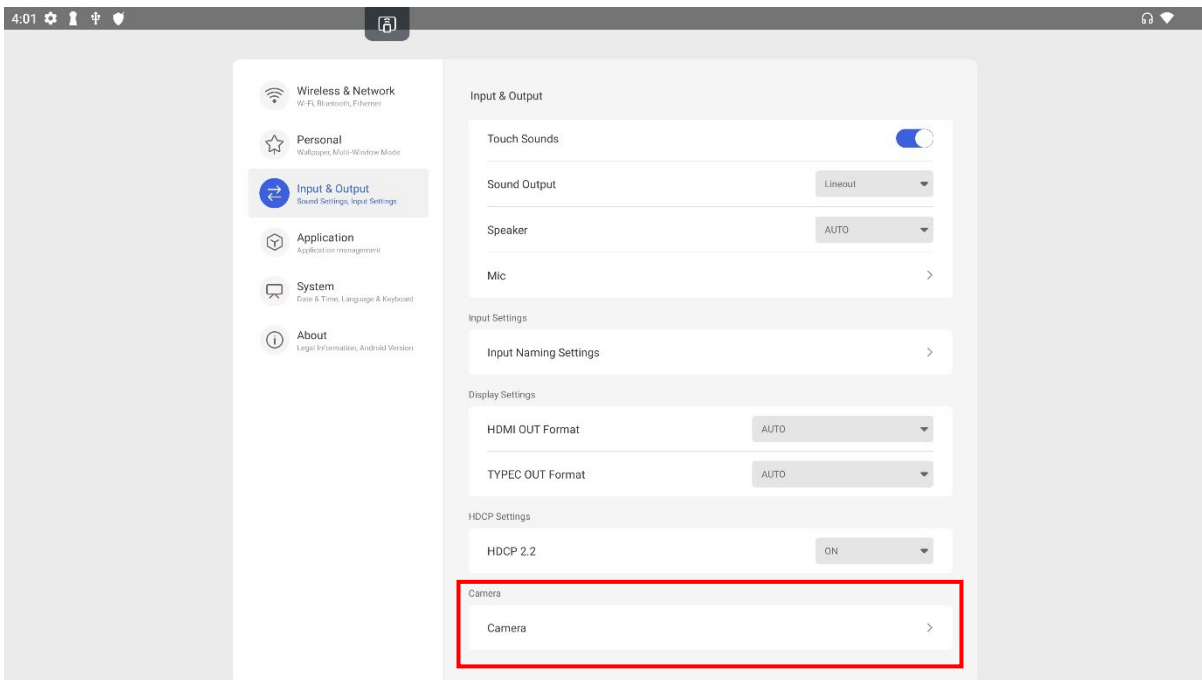


## How do I manually control my camera settings?

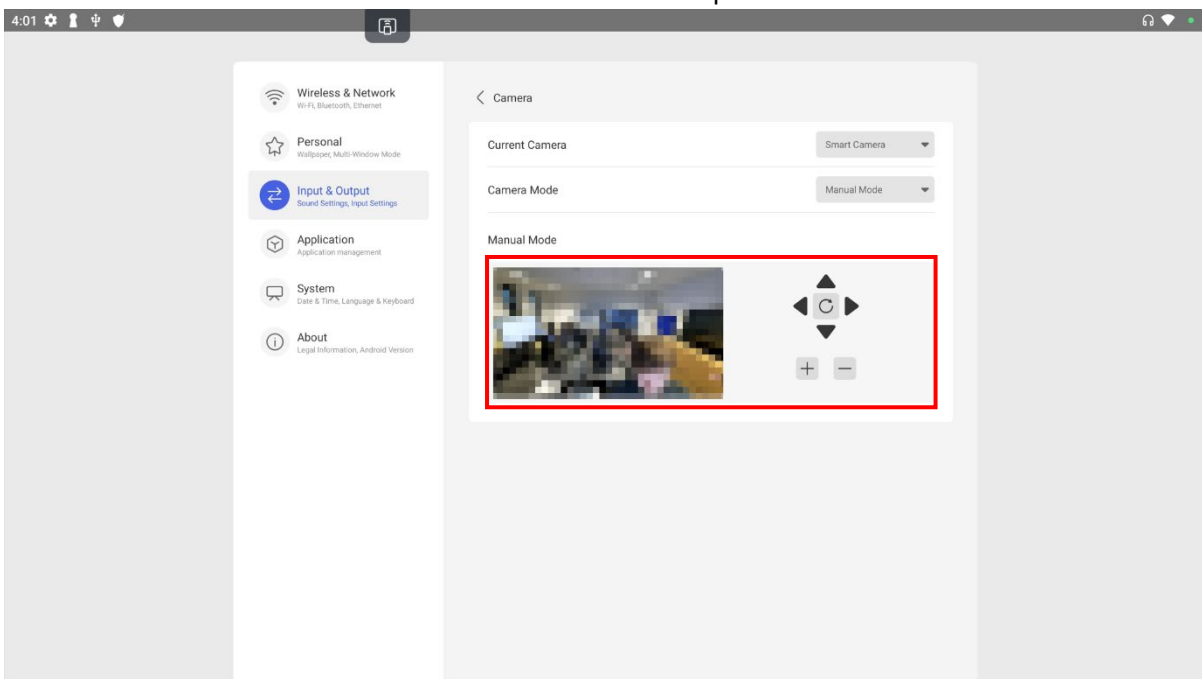
1. Open Settings > Input & Output



2. Select Camera



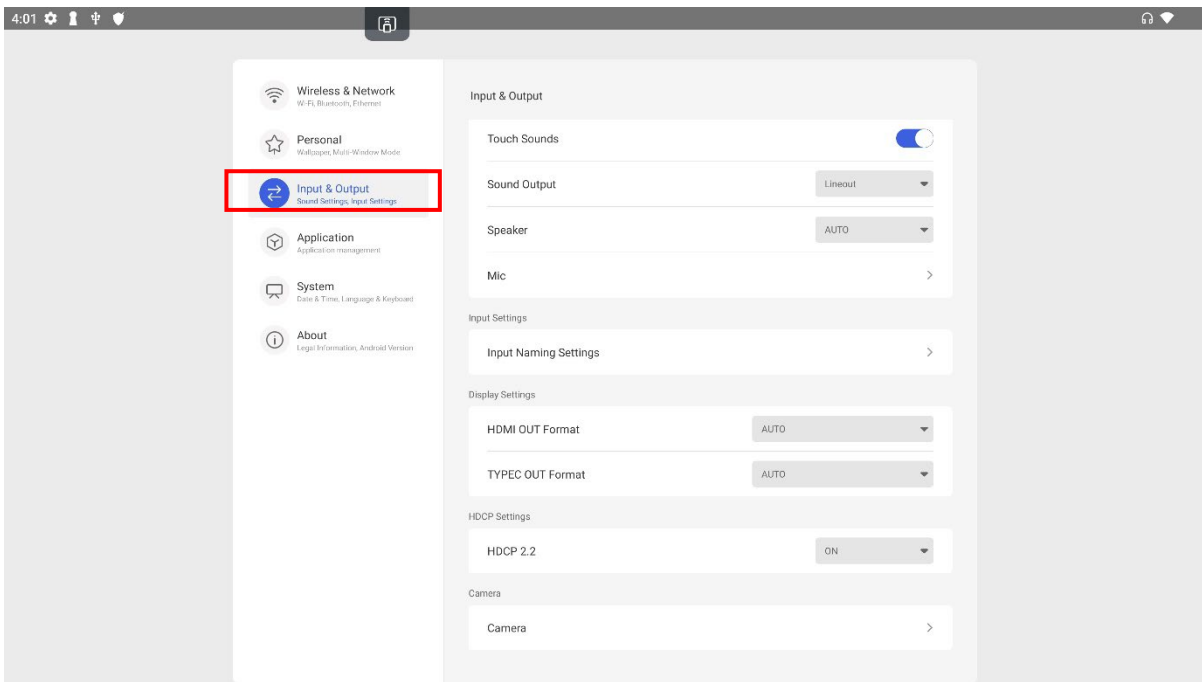
3. Use the interface under “Manual Mode” to control pan & zoom.



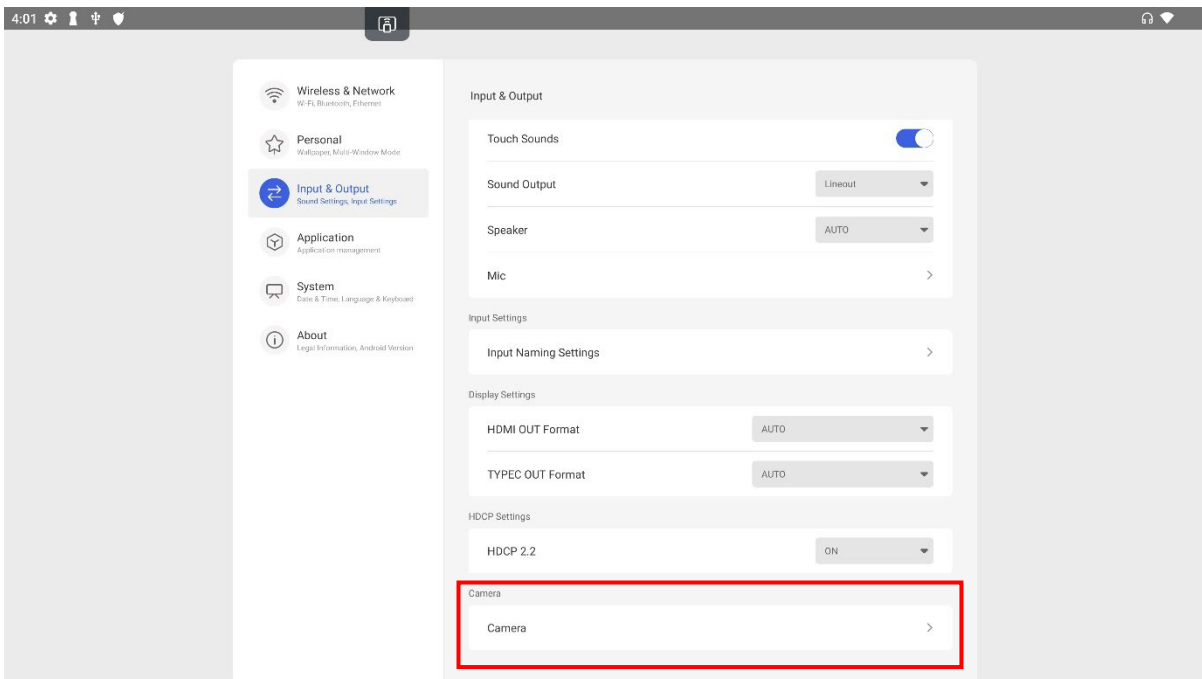
Note: Camera Mode needs to be set to “Manual Mode” to manually control the camera settings.


